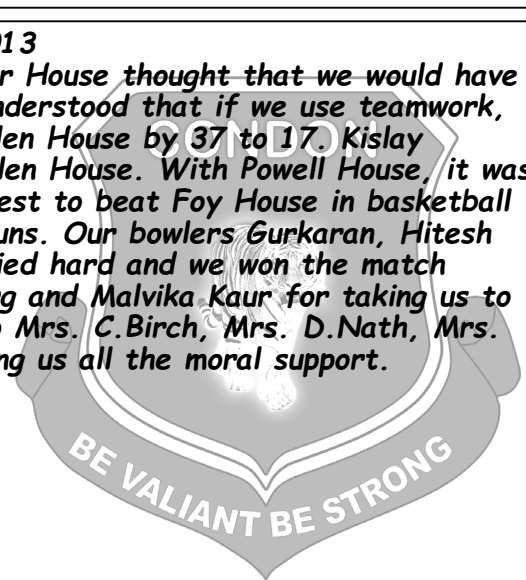

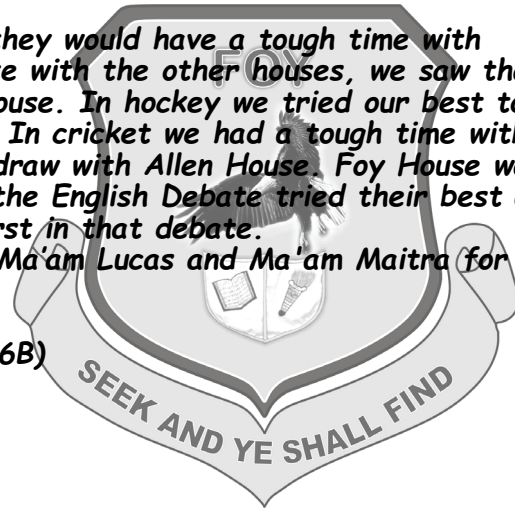




### FOY HOUSE REPORT

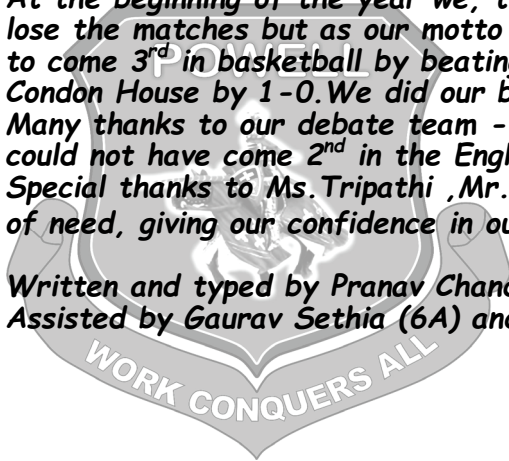

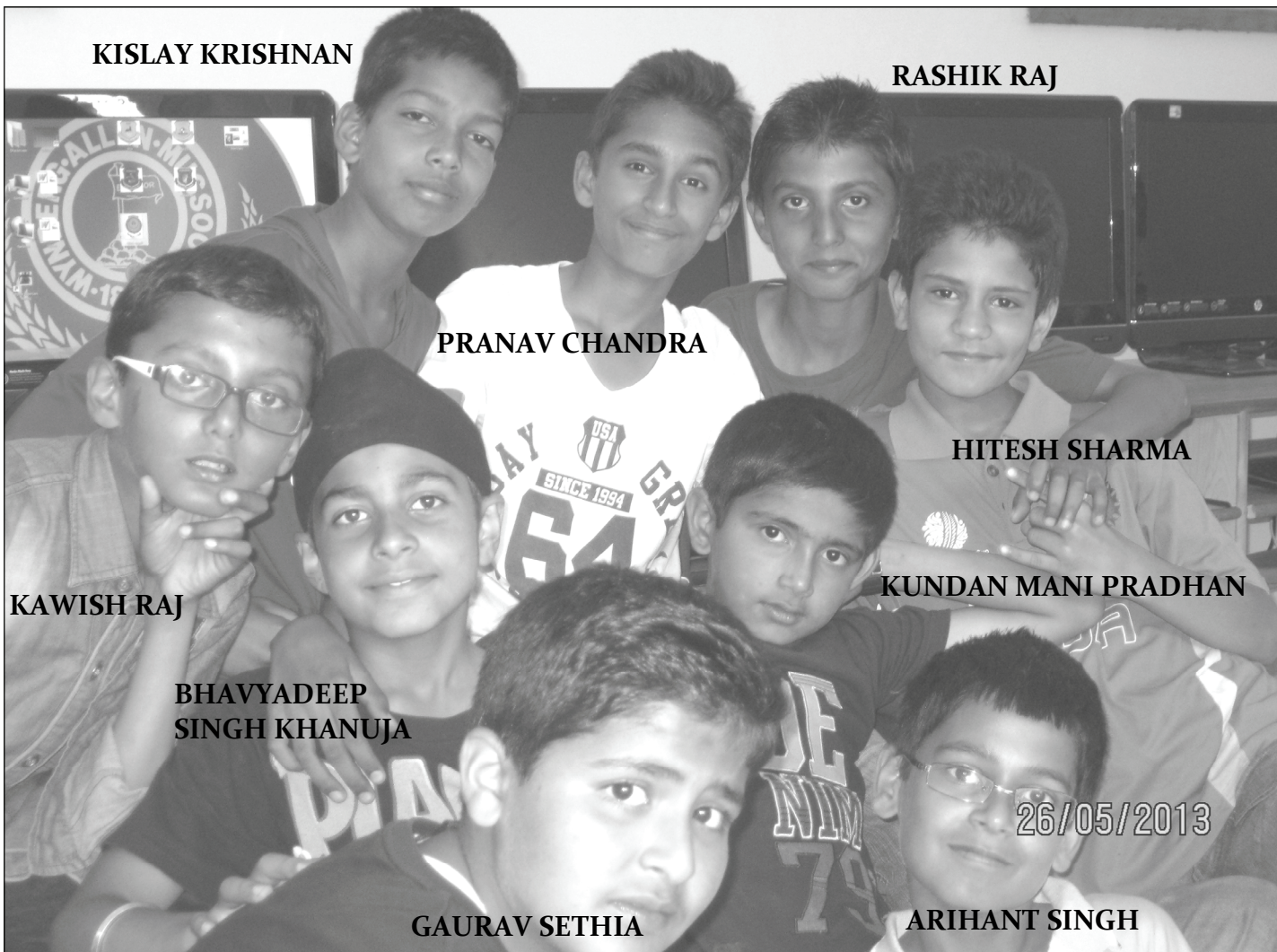
