Green Rain

Rain is water that falls from the sky. The water goes into the ground, streams, rivers and seas. Clouds in the sky are made up of small drops of water. When one drop of water in a cloud bumps into another drop, they join together to make a bigger drop. When the drops get too heavy for the cloud to hold, it falls to the ground as DPRNIAORS
Sometimes rain falls from only one cloud. So it only rains in one area. This is called a rain shower . During most rain showers, you can see the sun shining.
Rain water is a major source of water. In India, large areas of agricultural land depend on rainwater for irrigation. We get rains for a short period of time during theseason. (NOSOMON
Rainwater that seeps through the soil and collects over rocks is known as groundwater . Rainwater that runs off on the surface of the earth is called surface water .

Most rivers get flooded during monsoon and have much less water for the rest of the year. To solve this

problem **dams** are constructed at suitable locations on rivers.

Lightning is a giant electric spark in the air. Lightening is very hot. The heat from the lightning bolt makes all the air around it move away. This makes invisible ripples in the air. When the ripples are formed in the air, you can hear a loud noise.



The Proud Red Rose


